

RESOLUTION NO. 21-061

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DIXON TO ADOPT A CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PLAN AS REFERENCED IN ORDINANCE 14.02.1150 AND ASSOCIATED MASTER FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE WATER OPERATIONS DIVISION

WHEREAS, the Water Division was directed by the State of California Division of Drinking Water in the Sanitary Survey of 2017 to create a Cross-Connection Control Program (including Backflow Preventer Testing Program); and

WHEREAS, in order to implement a proper plan, a consultant specializing in the industry with knowledge of current rules and regulations set forth by the state will need to be hired by the City; and

WHEREAS, staff hired C&M Backflow (Purchase Order No. 849), an industry professional with over 25 years of knowledge and expertise in backflow testing, cross-connection, training etc.; and

WHEREAS, C&M Backflow, with the help of water staff, created a cross-connection program outlining the regulations, backflow testing protocols, standards and specifications of backflow preventers that are to be followed by the City and all water users in the City of Dixon's water system; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends updating associated fees for hydrant meter/backflows as follows:

Current Fees:

- Initial 100 units of usage \$ 404.00 (First 100 units @ \$4.04 per CCF unit)
- Fire hydrant application fee: \$75.00 (non-refundable)
- Equipment deposit: \$700.00
- Backflow test (first) and any relocation/retest: N/A
- Meter and backflow monthly rental: None Currently

Proposed Fees:

- Deposit: \$1,800.00 - Includes the following:
 - Fire hydrant application fee: \$ 100.00
 - Meter and backflow monthly rental: \$100.00
 - Usage rate per hundred (100) CCF: Rate based on current usage rate structure
 - Backflow test (first) and any relocation/retest: \$75.00; and


WHEREAS, staff recommends council adopting the proposed cross-connection plan and fees upon approving the ordinance 14.02.1150 CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL AND PREVENTION OF BACKFLOW STANDARDS, OF TITLE 14, WATER AND SEWERS, OF THE DIXON MUNICIPAL CODE; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DIXON adopt the proposed Cross-Connection Control Plan as referenced in ordinance 14.02.1150 CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL AND PREVENTION OF BACKFLOW STANDARDS, OF TITLE 14, WATER AND SEWERS, OF THE DIXON MUNICIPAL CODE and the associated master fee schedule for the City's Water Operations Division.
