

OVERVIEW

The City of Dixon is a growing community located on Interstate 80 in eastern Solano County, approximately 21 miles southwest of Sacramento and 65 miles east of San Francisco. Our location offers convenient access to the San Francisco Bay area as well as the recreational opportunities in the Sierras. The population of the community is approximately 20,000.

Home prices remain affordable compared to many areas of the state and the City is experiencing growth and new development. Dixon provides an ideal business location with excellent transportation access and a small town character where you can make as much of an impact as you choose. Dixon is located along Interstate 80 and near I-5 and I-505. The City is ten minutes from Davis and the world-class University of California Davis campus, 30 minutes from Sacramento and Sacramento International Airport, and a little more than an hour from the San Francisco Bay Area.
