

RESOLUTION NO. 26-065

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DIXON CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING BRUCE BARRETTE AS INTERIM PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, Government (Gov.) Code section 21221(h) of the Public Employees' Retirement Law permits the governing body to appoint a CalPERS retiree to a vacant position requiring specialized skills during recruitment for a permanent appointment, and provides that such appointment will not subject the retired person to reinstatement from retirement or loss of benefits so long as it is a single appointment that does not exceed 960 hours in a fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dixon City Council desires to appoint Bruce Barrette as an interim appointment retired annuitant to the vacant position of Public Works Director for the City of Dixon under Gov. Code section 21221(h), effective March 18, 2026; and

WHEREAS the City of Dixon City Council, the City of Dixon and Bruce Barrette certify that Bruce Barrette has not and will not receive a Golden Handshake or any other retirement-related incentive; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has authorized the search for a permanent appointment on March 17, 2026; and

WHEREAS, this Gov. Code section 21221(h) appointment shall only be made once and therefore will end on March 18, 2027, when the position is filled by a permanent employee, or where one party terminates the relationship, whichever comes first; and

WHEREAS, the entire appointment document between Bruce Barrette and the City of Dixon has been reviewed by this body and is attached herein; and

WHEREAS, the compensation paid to retirees cannot be less than the minimum nor exceed the maximum monthly base salary paid to other employees performing comparable duties, divided by 173.333 to equal the hourly rate; and

WHEREAS, the maximum base salary for this position is \$18,333.33 per month and the hourly equivalent is \$105.77 per hour; the minimum base salary for this position is \$15,166.67 and the hourly equivalent is \$87.50 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the hourly rate paid to Bruce Barrette will be \$100.00 per hour paid through MuniTemps Staffing Agency; and

WHEREAS, Bruce Barrette has not and will not receive any other benefit, incentive, compensation in lieu of benefit or other form of compensation in addition to this hourly pay rate; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Dixon City Council hereby certifies the nature of the appointment of Bruce Barrette as described herein and detailed in the attached appointment document and that this appointment is necessary to fill the critically needed position of Public Works Director for the City of Dixon by March 18, 2026 to ensure that the Public Works Department's critical day-to-day operations continue without disruption during this transition and recruitment for the full-time permanent position.
