## DIXON TO CELEBRATE 40TH ANNUAL NATIONAL NIGHT OUT

On Tuesday, August 1st, neighborhoods throughout Dixon are invited to join forces with thousands of communities nationwide for the “40th Annual National Night Out” (NNO) crime and drug prevention event. National Night Out is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch (NATW) and co-sponsored locally by the Dixon Police Department.

National Night Out, an annual community-building campaign, encourages residents to come together with local law enforcement agencies, elected officials, and community organizations. From 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. on August 1st, residents in neighborhoods throughout Dixon and across the nation, are asked to lock their doors, turn on outside lights and spend the evening outside with neighbors, police, and fire.

As part of Nation Night Out, staff from City Departments and Councilmembers will join police and fire to visit registered neighborhood block parties throughout the City. The last day to register for a National Night Out block party is Friday, July 28, 2023.

# TIPS TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SCAMMERS ONLINE AND OVER THE PHONE

The rise of technology has also brought an increase in internet and telephone scams, making it easier for criminals to deceive and steal from unsuspecting victims. As a community, it's important that we take steps to protect ourselves from these scams.

Here are some tips to help prevent you from becoming the victim of internet and telephone scams:

- Be cautious of unsolicited calls or emails from unfamiliar individuals or organizations.
- Do not provide personal information, such as social security numbers, bank account numbers, or passwords, over the phone or the internet.
- Be wary of any calls or emails claiming that you have won a prize or are in trouble with the law. Legitimate organizations do not typically communicate in this manner.
- Do not click on links or download attachments from unknown sources. These could contain malware or viruses.
- If you receive a call or email that you suspect is a scam, hang up or delete the message immediately and do not respond.
- If you have fallen victim to a scam, report it to the police and file a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission.

Remember, scammers are experts at tricking people into giving away their personal information. By being vigilant and aware of these tactics, you can protect yourself and your hard-earned money.

Limited Time Introductory Offer of \$50 for a monthly pass (regularly \$90) for riders traveling between Sacramento and Vacaville or Dixon.



Solano Express Blue Line riders starting their commute in Vacaville or Dixon who purchased a monthly pass in the last six months and commute to Sacramento are eligible for the introductory price of \$50.



Solano Express Blue Line riders who purchase a monthly pass and start their commute south of Vacaville can transfer in Vacaville to the Solano Mobility Express Vanpool for *FREE*.
