



Hall Park

East A Street



At 48.8 acres, Hall Park is the largest park in Dixon, and is located in the southeast corner of Dixon below East A Street. It is adjacent to the Dixon May Fair and north of Dixon High School. This park is where Dixon City Hall is located as well as the Senior Multi-Use Center, Pat Granucci Aquatics Center and skate park. Other amenities include two playgrounds for ages 5 – 12, restrooms, concessions, dog park and covered/group picnic areas that can accommodate groups up to 30. Sports facilities include three softball fields, one baseball field, three little league fields, one full basketball court, one soccer field, and 3 multi-use fields. Not included as part of the park's acreage calculations, but still part of the park property, is an additional 9 acres of undeveloped land. These additional acres should be considered for future development.
