WHEREAS, California Government Code 66014(a) stipulates that user fees charged by local agencies may not exceed the estimated reasonable cost of providing the service for which the fee is charged; and

WHEREAS, the City Council at a regular meeting on April 20, 2021, conducted a public hearing and adopted the Master Fee Schedule with February 2021 All Urban Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward area and subsequent annual updates based on the All Urban Consumers Price Index (CPI) for the San Francisco-Oakland-Hayward area, December 12-Month Percent Change; and

WHEREAS, the December 2023 to December 2024 12-Month Percent Change of the CPI is 2.4%; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Dixon hereby adopts the updated Master Fee Schedule based on the CIP of 2.4%. The fees/rates shall become effective after a 60-day waiting period on July 1, 2025 with the exception of the Finance Department fees, which will become effective on January 1, 2026.
