# Pat Granucci Aquatic Center

The Pat Granucci Aquatic Center provides a safe, welcoming space for residents of all ages to enjoy swimming and water-based activities. Our seasonal pools offer opportunities for recreation, fitness, and skill development, all supervised by certified lifeguards. Programs and services are designed to support water safety, healthy lifestyles, and most of all community fun.

## Facility Features

The facility features three (3) pools designed to accommodate swimmers of all ages and abilities.

**-The Competition Pool** which is 25 yards long, with depths ranging from approximately 3 feet to 9 feet, and includes lane lines for lap swimming, a diving board and is ADA-accessible.

**-Training Pool** is 25 yards long with depths ranging from about 2 to 3 feet shallow water, full-length steps, and ADA access.

**-The Wading Pool (Baby Pool)** ideal for young swimmers, with beach-style entry, unheated interactive water features, and a maximum depth of approximately 1.5 feet.

## Lap Swim

Lap Swim is generally available from March through October at the Pat Granucci Aquatic Center and offers a dedicated time for fitness-focused swimming in the Competition Pool. With eight lanes available, participants may swim laps, water walk, or complete their own independent water workouts at their own pace. Kickboards, pull buoys, and water aerobics equipment are available upon request to support a variety of fitness levels and workout styles.

## Recreation Swim

Recreation Swim offers the community an opportunity to enjoy the pool during designated open swim hours. This unstructured swim time allows participants to swim and play under supervision of the Lifeguards on duty.

For safety reasons, children ages 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times. All patrons under 18 years of age are required to pass a swim test to enter the competition pool.

All patrons must follow posted pool rules and lifeguard instructions. The City reserves the right to refuse service and remove individuals who fail to comply

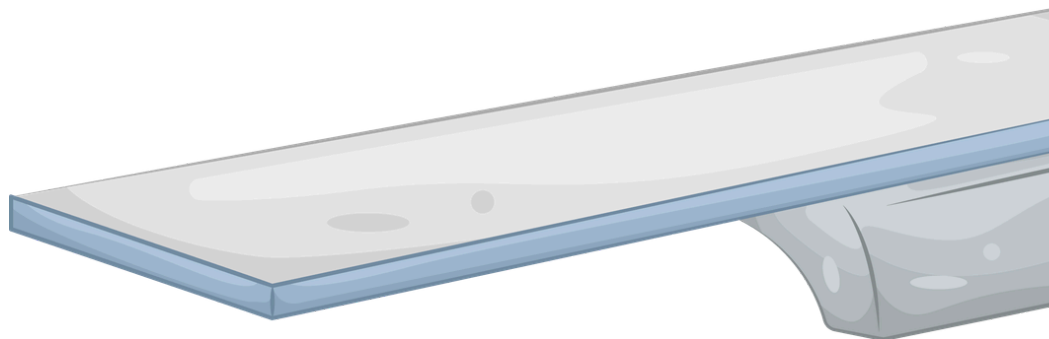

## Swim Lessons

Introduce your child to the joy of swimming with the City of Dixon's Summer Swim Lesson Program at the Pat Granucci Aquatic Center! Lessons are offered in two-week sessions and are designed to build confidence, safety, and strong swimming skills in a fun and supportive environment.

City staff make every effort to place swimmers in the appropriate level by assessing participants on the first day of class and grouping swimmers based on skill level. Class adjustments may be made at the beginning of each session to ensure the best learning experience for every swimmer.

- **Parent/Tot Group Lessons** (Ages 0–3): A parent-participation class that introduces water comfort and basic skills through guided activities.
- **Group Swim Lessons:**
  - Beginner (Ages 3–5)
  - Beginner (Ages 6–12)
  - Intermediate (Ages 5–12)
  - Advanced (Ages 6–17)
- **Private Swim Lessons:** One-on-one instruction for swimmers of any age, tailored to individual goals and skill levels.







## Not sure which level?

Detailed descriptions of each swim level, including skills taught and age guidelines, are available on the City of Dixon Recreation webpage to help you select the best fit for your swimmer. Registration for swim lessons begins April 1, and swimmers will also be assessed on the first day of lessons to ensure proper placement.



## Lifeguard Certification

The City of Dixon employs aquatics staff through the March – October season to lifeguard for programs that include: lap/recreational swim, swim team practice, and private pool rentals. Upward mobility is available; we coach and train staff to achieve high proficiency in lifeguarding skills. The skills learned from lifeguarding (problem-solving, communication, teamwork, leadership) are invaluable and transferrable to other jobs and fields of study.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a Lifeguarding, CPR, AED, and Title 22 First Aid certification (valid for two years, and accepted nation-wide), and will be eligible to apply for the City of Dixon Lifeguard position.

The city hosts lifeguard certification courses in March of each year.

## JR. Lifeguard Camp

The Jr. Lifeguard/Swim Instructor Camp is a 5-day program designed for youth ages 10–14 who are interested in lifeguarding and swim instruction. Participants receive hands-on training that introduces the skills, responsibilities, and teamwork involved in both roles. Participants learn basic skills, safety awareness, and professionalism in an aquatics setting. Swimming prerequisites apply.

## **Senior/Multi-Use Center (SMUC)**

The City of Dixon Senior/ Multi-Use Center (SMUC) provides a welcoming space for older adults to connect, stay active, and participate in a variety of programs and activities. The Senior Center offers general services, social opportunities, and recreational programming designed to support wellness, engagement, and community connection.

Programs and special events are updated monthly and shared through the Senior Center calendar. Digital calendars are available on the City of Dixon Recreation website, printed copies are available at the Senior Center, and members of the Dixon Senior Club may also receive calendars by mail. # Dixon Parks

## Names, Locations, & What's There



### **Conejo Park**

3.61 acre neighborhood park at the corner of Weigand Way and Gill Drive in northern Dixon.

- Open lawn, covered picnic area, a perimeter walking path, play apparatus for ages 2-5 & 5-12.

### **Northwest Park**

22.53 acre community park at the corner of W H Street and N Lincoln Street in Central Dixon.

- Features several informal long fields, a perimeter walking loop, a full basketball court, a covered picnic area, play apparatuses for ages 2 – 5 & 5 - 12.



### **Patwin Park**

4.93 acre neighborhood park Located on W H Street and Pheasant Run Drive.

- Picnic / BBQ facilities, useable open space, a half basketball court, outdoor exercise facilities, play apparatuses for ages 2-5 & 5-12.





### **Bowen Park**

4-acre park within the Homestead Specific Planning Area.

- Picnicking facilities, shade structure, multi-use open space, walking paths, a half basketball court, play apparatuses for ages 2-5 & 5-12.

### **Veterans Park**

5 acre neighborhood park is located between Valley Glen Drive and Legion Avenue on the southern part of the City of Dixon.

- Picnic / BBQ facilities, two half basketball courts, expanse of useable open space, play apparatuses for ages 2-5 & 5-12.



### **Hall Park**

The largest park in Dixon at 48.8 acres, is in the southeast corner of Dixon below East A Street.

- Covered/group picnic areas, a dog park, skate park, two playgrounds for ages 5 – 12.
- Sports facilities include three softball fields, one baseball field, three little league fields, one full basketball court, one soccer field, and 3 multi-use fields.
- This park is where Dixon City Hall is located as well as the Senior Multi-Use Center, & Pat Granucci Aquatic Center





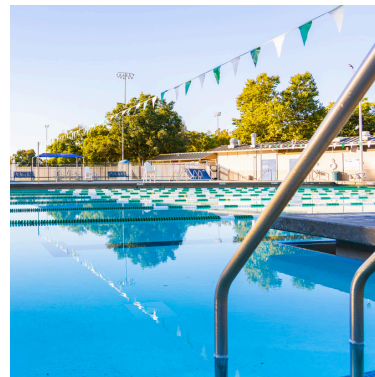
# Rentals & Reservations

# Senior / Multi- Use Center

The Dixon Senior / Multi-Use Center operates as a Senior Center Monday through Friday until 2:30 p.m. After 2:30 p.m. on weekdays & all-day on weekends, the facility is available for rentals. Rooms within the Center may be reserved for meetings, celebrations, and special events.



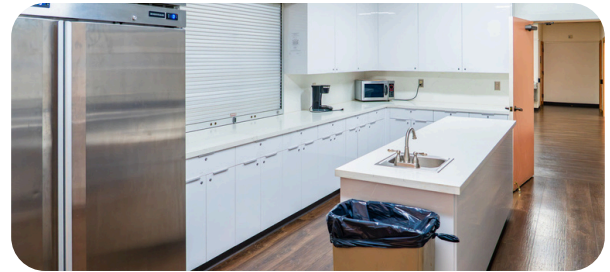
## Assembly Hall

- Approximately 50 ft x 40 ft open event space.
- Wood flooring with a flexible layout for various event types.
- Pass-through window to the kitchen.
- Capacity 120 people, can be reserved up to six months in advance.



## Arts & Craft Room

- Approximately 20 ft x 20 ft flexible layout to accommodate classes, meetings, or small gatherings.
- Windows overlooking the park and pool, providing natural light.
- Can be rented individually or used as an add-on to the Assembly Hall.



## Kitchen

- Approximately 20 ft x 15 ft with central kitchen island for prep and serving.
- Pass-through window connecting to the Assembly Hall.
- Equipped with refrigerator, two ovens, a flat-top cooking surface, six gas stovetop burners, & large sink.

# Senior / Multi- Use Center

## General Rental Policies

Rentals at the Dixon Senior / Multi-Use Center include the use of 20 8- foot tables and 120 chairs at no additional cost. Renters may also bring their own tables if preferred.

An application to rent must be submitted in person, and a deposit is required to secure the date and time of the event. A non-resident fee applies to renters who do not reside in Dixon. Additional fees or discounts may apply. Cancellation fees apply and are based on how far in advance notice is given.

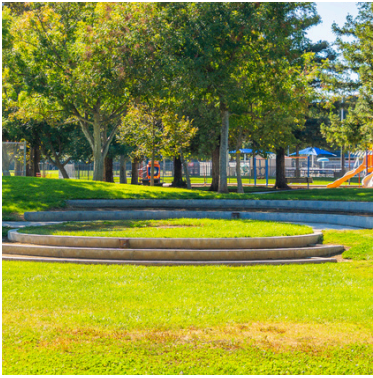
Rental packages are available to fit different group sizes and event needs. Options include access to the 2-Pool Complex (Competition Pool and Training Pool) or the 3-Pool Complex (Competition Pool, Training Pool, and Wading Pool). All pool rentals include certified lifeguard supervision to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience. Availability and permitted activities may vary by season and staffing.

# Multi-Use Fields

Multi-Use Fields are wide, open grass areas available for rent and suitable for a variety of sports, activities, and special events. These fields are typically located near other park amenities and attractions, making them a flexible and convenient option for gatherings and recreational use. These can be rented unlighted or lighted at different prices per hour.

## Baseball/Softball Fields

Dixon's baseball and softball fields vary in size to accommodate different age groups and levels of play. All fields are well maintained and located within the same general park area at Hall Park. Three baseball fields are grouped together, as are three softball fields, creating a convenient and cohesive sports complex. Adjacent multi-use fields provide additional space for practices, warm-ups, or other activities. Fields are available for rent when not in use by local nonprofit sports organizations. These can be rented unlighted or lighted at different prices per hour.
